

\_\_\_\_\_ Make a border that goes around the two pages you are using. This border needs to show a pattern. Draw things that begin with the letter E and/or write cursive Es in the pattern of your border.

\_\_\_\_\_ Make a row of Cursive Capital Es just beneath your upper border, and a row of lower-case cursive es beneath that.

\_\_\_ Country Study: Read about England. Locate and color England on the map of the world. Write 3 facts about England in your own words. Do not copy directly from your book or other sources.

\_\_\_\_\_ Spelling: This week we are working on words that end in -le. The Spelling Words are handle, trouble, simple, people, middle, table, little, gentle, poodle, pickle, noodle, saddle, juggle, uncle, riddle. Please write the spelling list in your homework book. Study the list for a test on October 20th.
